AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO TERM CONTRACT NO. NP 1368

This Amendment is made and entered into upon execution by both parties by and between **Sarasota County**, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as the "**County**," and **School Board of Sarasota County**, **Florida** a Florida Corporation hereinafter referred to as "**School Board**."

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the County and the School Board entered into Term Contract No. NP 1368 ("Contract") for the purpose of providing human services and/or public welfare programs which are of common interest and benefit to the residents of Sarasota County.

WHEREAS, on March 8, 2023, the Sarasota County Board of County Commissioners authorized the extension of the funding for the Contract through September 30, 2023, and authorized the County Administrator to execute this Amendment.

WHEREAS, the parties now wish to amend the Contract.

NOW THEREFORE, the County and the School Board, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, do agree to amend the Contract as follows:

This is a fixed price, unit cost Contract. The County shall pay the School Board through payment issued by the Clerk for the Circuit Court in accordance with the Local Government Prompt Payment Act, §218.70, et seq. F.S., upon receipt of the School Board's payment request forms and written approval of same by the County's Contract Manager indicating that services have been rendered in conformity with this Contract. No funds shall be advanced by the County to or on behalf of the School Board. AMENDMENT NO. 2 EXHIBIT A SCOPE OF SERVICES

The School Board of Sarasota County, Florida – Suncoast Technical College will provide General Educational Development (GED) Classes for up to 30 active participants awaiting placement in the program and also to cover costs of GED tests and/or the equivalent amount for subject tests not to exceed the total GED award.

The School Board of Sarasota County, Florida - Sarasota County Technical Institute will provide an instructor to provide GED classes. The instructor will:

- provide GED classes one time per week for two hours;
- assess each GED class participant to determine level of education and skill level;
- schedule GED class participants to take the GED test as appropriate;
- participate in staffings and team meetings as appropriate;
- share assessments and information, both written and verbal, related to individual program participants and potential participants with the collaborating service providers as appropriate; and
- track and report on the assigned community success factors.
